Willard FFA Competes in County and Sub-District Soil Judging Contests

The Agricultural and Urban Soils contests are educational activities designed as a practical method of teaching students to evaluate land and soil and to make decisions when faced with soil related issues that affect agricultural production. Students are asked to evaluate soil textures and properties, measure the slope of the land, and make construction or farm recommendations based on their conclusions.

Willard FFA sent two teams of members to the county and district soil judging contests this fall. The rural soils judging team included Caley Legg, Kathleen Schaaf, Annie Cummings and Phillip Bogner and the urban judging team included Chad Bivens, Raven Brant, Martha Alejandro, and Lesley Burton.

At district soils, the Willard FFA urban team placed 7th out of 24 teams. Phillip Bogner led the team, followed by Kathleen Schaaf, Annie Cummings, and Caley Legg. The rural team placed 12th out of 24 teams. Martha Alejandro and Lesley Burton both led the team with a tied score followed by Raven Brant and Chad Bivens.


